  coverage for the duration of their breast, cervical, colorectal or prostate cancer treatment.
- **Grassroots Organizations:** These are grass roots, freestanding organizations that provide a range of supportive/educational services for individuals diagnosed with breast cancer. In addition, they have breast cancer survivors in significant decision-making roles within the organization.

# IN READING MAMMOGRAMS, MORE IS BETTER

Radiologists who read a higher volume of mammograms find more cancers than radiologists who read a low volume of mammograms. (*Journal of the National Cancer Institute*) The population of women screened also influences accuracy. For instance, accuracy is more likely if menstruating women have a mammogram during the first or second week of the menstrual cycle, when breast tissue is less dense. Finally, women are

more likely to get accurate mammogram readings if they go to the same facility and/or ensure that prior films are available for the radiologist to compare.
